



Financial Aid Requirements:

- Crossfire UNITED Oregon will consider all applications for financial aid or scholarship for families in need.
- This is a special privilege. Crossfire UNITED Oregon does this because we believe all athletes should be able to develop to the best of their ability. Your child will receive all of the same benefits as his/her teammates.
- In return, we expect your athlete to participate in all team activities.
- The Crossfire UNITED Oregon scholarship committee will review each application, keeping all information confidential.
- In order for you to qualify for aid, you must submit the following:
 - Player: write a 500 word essay explaining why you want to play soccer and why you want to play for Crossfire UNITED Oregon.
 - Parents: must submit the following information prior to consideration
 - Complete financial aid form
 - Copy of pay stubs, W2 forms, 1099, or 1040 for 2018 for both parents
 - Copy of your house payment or rental agreement
 - \$100 fee which will cover tryout fees and your first payment
- Your fees are determined by the Scholarship Committee not by your coach.
- Your fees will be determined based on your income, the number of people in your family and the number of players applying for scholarship. There are no “full scholarships” available.
- Your scholarship covers your club fees only. You will have other expenses including your uniform, tournament fees, and travel.
- If you apply and receive financial aid, you are entering into a legal contract with THUSC/Crossfire United.
- The club will not issue a player card until your contract is signed and returned to the club.
- If you are approved for a scholarship, you will be required to make monthly payments towards your balance.
- If you miss two payments, your player card will be revoked until you pay.
- If you cannot pay, you will need to contact the Club at (503-616-9424) and explain your circumstances.
- If you decide to leave Crossfire UNITED Oregon during the year, you will forfeit your scholarship and be expected to pay the full posted program fee. Crossfire UNITED Oregon will not release your player card to any other club or program until you pay off the entire fee plus any amount owed for team fees. If you pay by check, the club will wait until the check clears before releasing your card.
 - If your child is injured and cannot play (Doctor’s note required) or you move more than 100 miles from the Portland area (proof required), or have significant life event (after approval by the board) you will only be required to pay your original scholarship amount in order to release your player card.

Your child has been approved for financial aid for the 2019-20 season. This is a special opportunity. Crossfire UNITED Oregon wants to make sure that you understand what is expected of you and your child to maintain your scholarship.

- You are required to participate in practices, games and tournaments. If you are unable to make it to any of these events, you must notify the team coach personally as soon as possible.
- Your scholarship covers your ECNL Crossfire UNITED Oregon fees only. You will have other expenses including your uniform, tournament fees, and travel expenses which are not covered by the scholarship.
- You are required to pay a total of \$_____. You may make monthly payments of \$____ due the last Wednesday of the month.
- Payments may be mailed to 515 NW Saltzman, PMB 821 Portland OR 97229. If you want to pay by cash- call 503-708-8056
- Do not give cash or payments to your coach or team manager.
- If you are two payments or more behind, you will not be allowed to play until you have paid the club the entire amount owed to that date. Your player card will be suspended and your coach notified that you are not available. The same policy will apply to all players in the club.
- If you are unable to pay the club, you must contact the club at 503-616-9424 with an explanation and a plan for payment. The Scholarship Committee will decide whether or not to allow you an extension on your payments.
- If you decide to leave Crossfire UNITED Oregon during the year, you will be expected to pay the full posted club fees. You will lose your scholarship. Crossfire UNITED Oregon will not release your player card to any other club or program until you pay off the entire fee plus any amount owed for team fees. If you pay by check, the club will wait until the check clears before releasing your card.
